

# Enchanted


Finished size 56 1/2" x 68 1/2", Block sizes: 6 1/2"

For best results read all instructions first. Use 1/4" seams throughout, all measurements include this 1/4" seam allowance. When cutting strips and pieces use a rotary cutter and clear ruler. Have fun!

## Cutting-

From the white print, cut:

6 strips 4" x 40"

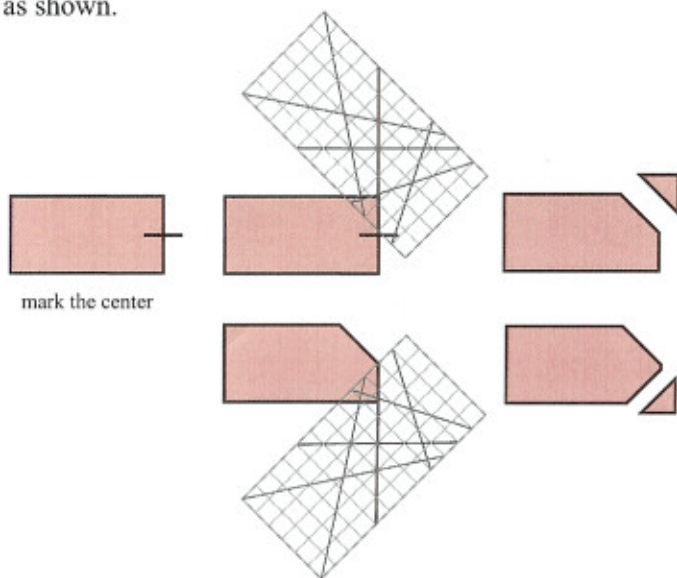
20 squares 4 3/4", cut in half twice diagonally. 

From the pink print, cut:

6 strips 1 3/4" x 40"

40 rectangle 2 1/4" x 4"

Using a rotary ruler marked with a 45 degree angle, mark the center. Cut one end of a rectangle, starting at the center mark, at a 45 degree angle as shown. Turn ruler and cut another 45 degree angle on the same end, as shown.



From the dark brown print, cut:

6 strips 1 3/4" x 40"

7 strips 2 1/2" x 40"

40 rectangles 2 1/4" x 4"

Repeat above step to create same type of shape.

From the dark yellow print, cut:

20 squares 2 1/4"

From the green print, cut:

6 squares 6 1/2"

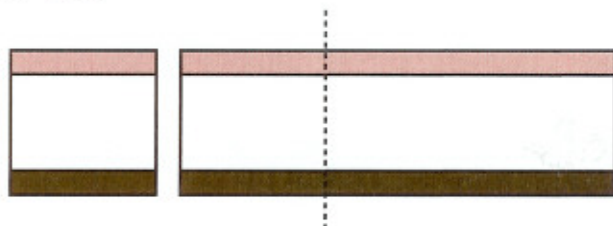
From the large floral print, fussy cut:

6 squares 6 1/2"

Fussy cut means to cut the square around the flowers wanted in the floral print. Just try to cut from the edges of the fabric piece to leave enough fabric for the border. Cut the border as described in the border instructions.

## Piecing the Blocks-

1. Sew one pink 1 3/4" x 40" strip, one dark brown 1 3/4" x 40" strip, and one white 4" x 40" strip together as shown. Press toward the pink and brown strips. Repeat to make 6 strip sets. Cut strip sets into 31 strip set blocks, 6 1/2" wide.



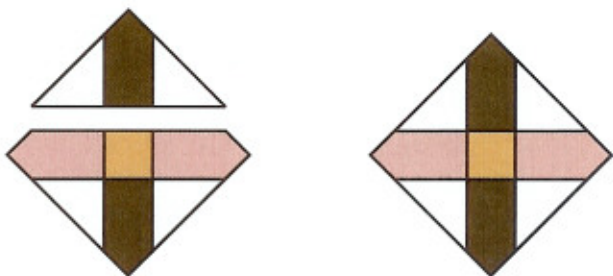
2. Sew two 2 1/4" x 4" pink shapes and one dark yellow 2 1/4" square together, as shown. Press toward the pink print. Make 20 units.



3. Sew two white print 4 3/4" triangles and one dark brown 2 1/4" x 4" dark brown shape, as shown. Press toward the brown print. Make 40 units.



4. Sew one unit from the step 2 and two units from step 3 together. Press toward the dark brown unit. Make 20 6 1/2" square crossing blocks.



## Putting it together-

1. Referring to the quilt layout diagram, lay out the quilt in 7 rows across and 9 rows down using the 31 strip set blocks, 20 crossing blocks, the green print 6 1/2" squares, and the fussy cut floral 6 1/2" squares.

2. Sew blocks in rows pressing in opposite directions. Sew the rows together matching seams. Press.
